A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION FOR ELECTRICITY PAYMENTS STATEWIDE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
- 2 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 3 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.
- 4 SECTION 2. The purpose of this Act is to make emergency
- 5 appropriations to address a \$1,276,000 deficit in electricity
- 6 payments for department of accounting and general services
- 7 managed facilities statewide and a \$6,400,000 deficit in
- 8 electricity payments for facilities in the University of Hawaii
- 9 system. Since local utility companies are dependent upon oil as
- 10 the primary source of fuel, the steady rise in world oil prices
- 11 has directly contributed to this shortfall. Although kilowatt
- 12 per hour consumption has remained flat or decreased, increased
- 13 worldwide demand and natural disasters like Hurricane Katrina
- 14 have increased oil prices.
- 15 Based on a combination of actual bills paid and projected
- 16 cost, the shortfall for fiscal year 2005-2006 is as follows:
