#### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DENTISTS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Act 166, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004, is
- 2 amended by amending section 3 to read as follows:
- 3 "SECTION 3. Chapter 448, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 4 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 5 and to read as follows:
- 6 "\$448- Community service license. (a) The board of
- 7 dental examiners may issue, without examination, a community
- 8 service license to practice dentistry in the employment of a
- 9 federally qualified health center, Native Hawaiian health
- 10 systems center, or post-secondary dental auxiliary training
- 11 program accredited by the American Dental Association Commission
- 12 on Dental Accreditation. Community service licensees under this
- 13 section shall abide by the requirements and conditions placed
- 14 upon those fully licensed under this chapter.
- 15 Eliqible candidates shall:
- 16 (1) Provide copies of documentation and credentials that
- include but are not limited to:

1		(A) A diploma or certificate of graduation from a
2		dental college accredited by the American Dental
3		Association Commission on Dental Accreditation,
4		recognized and approved by the board; and
5		(B) Either of the following:
6		(i) A certificate or other evidence satisfactory

8		National Board Dental Examination within
9		five years of the date of request; or
10		(ii) Evidence of active practice of clinical
11		dentistry of not less than one thousand
12		hours per year for the three years
13		immediately prior to the date of request;
andy.	(2)	Provide a copy of an active, unrestricted dental
15		practice license from another state;
16	(3)	Disclose to the board of dental examiners all previous
17		and pending legal or regulatory action relating to
18		claims of malpractice, or personal or professional
19		misconduct; and
20	(4)	Pay applicable registration fees, which shall be one
21		half of the prevailing biennial registration fee for
22		dentistry.

### S.B. NO. 2776

- 1 No person who after the effective date of this Act has failed to
- 2 pass the license examination administered under this chapter
- 3 shall have the benefit of a community service dental license.
- 4 (b) Community service licensees shall actively participate
- 5 in a formal and ongoing program of clinical quality assurance.
- 6 (c) A license may be renewed [annually] biennially,
- 7 pending review and reauthorization of the board of dental
- 8 examiners.
- 9 (d) A community service license authorizes the licensee to
- 10 practice dentistry only within the employment of an eliqible
- 11 organization and shall be in force until the earliest of the
- 12 following occurs:
- 13 (1) The date the person leaves the employment authorized
- under the community service license;
- 15 (2) The date on which the results of the license
- examination taken by the person under this chapter are
- posted by the board;
- 18 (3) The date the community service license expires; or
- 19 (4) The date on which the board revokes the community
- service license; provided that the board may revoke
- the community service license at any time for cause.

1 Commissioned officers of the United States Army, the 2 United States Navy, the United States Air Force, the United 3 States Public Health Service, or the United States Veterans 4 Administration practicing in a federally qualified health center 5 or Native Hawaiian health systems center shall qualify for a 6 community service license to practice dentistry, which may be 7 issued for the term of the officer's federal duty assignment. 8 Officers shall provide to the board of dental examiners: 9 (1)A copy of an active, unrestricted dental practice 10 license from another state; and 11 (2) A copy of documentation reflecting official duty 12 assignment to a qualifying community service dental 13 license site."" SECTION 2. Act 166, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004, is 15 amended by amending section 7 to read as follows: 16 "SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect upon its approval 17 [and shall be repealed on July 1, 2009; provided that sections 18 448 9 and 448 9.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall be reenacted 19 in the form in which they read on the day before the approval of 20 this Act]."

1 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed

2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
