A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE FISH.

RE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The humuhumunukunukuapua'a (Rhinecanthus
 2 rectangulus), also known as the rectangular triggerfish, was
- 3 designated as the official fish of the State in 1985. However,
- 4 the enabling legislation was automatically repealed by operation
- 5 of law in 1990, five years after the date of approval. Many
- 6 among the general public, however, mistakenly assume that the
- 7 humuhumunukunukuapua'a is still the state fish. The legislature
- 8 finds that Hawaii does not currently have a fish designated as
- 9 the official fish of the State.
- 10 The purpose of this Act is to permanently establish the
- 11 humuhumunukunukuapua'a as the official fish of the State.
- 12 SECTION 2. Chapter 5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 13 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
- 14 read as follows:
- 15 "§5- State fish. The humuhumunukunukuapua'a
- 16 (Rhinecanthus rectangulus), also known as the rectangular
- 17 triggerfish, is established and designated as the official fish
- 18 of the State."

- 2 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
