A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HIGHER EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 226, Session
- 2 Laws of Hawaii 2004, established the higher education statutory
- 3 analysis interim study group and required the study group to
- 4 suggest an improved organizational framework for statutes
- 5 relating to higher education and the University of Hawaii,
- 6 recommending statutes for consolidation, amendment, or repeal.
- 7 The Act further required the study group to submit its findings
- 8 and recommendations, including proposed legislation, to the
- 9 legislature no later than twenty days before the convening of
- 10 the regular session of 2005.
- The study group was co-chaired by:
- 12 (1) Representative K. Mark Takai, chair of the house
- committee on higher education; and
- 14 (2) Senator Norman Sakamoto, chair of the senate committee
- on education.
