- 15 SECTION 8. If any provision of this Act, or the
- 16 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held
- 17 invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or
- 18 applications of the Act, which can be given effect without the
- 19 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions
- 20 of this Act are severable.
- 21 SECTION 9. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
