A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AFFORDABLE HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1	. Chapter 201H, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by add	ing a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:	
4	"§201H- Land leases to nonprofit organizations providing	
5	affordable hou	sing. (a) Notwithstanding any provision to the
6	contrary, the	administration, pursuant to section 201H-4(b), may
7	lease land to	any qualified nonprofit organization providing
8	affordable hou	sing, under the following terms and conditions:
9	(1) Leas	es shall be for ninety-nine years at \$1 per year
10	per	parcel; and
11	<u>(2)</u> The	instrument of lease shall include provisions,
12	enfo	rceable by the administration, that the land
13	shal	1:
14	<u>(A)</u>	Be used only for providing affordable housing
15		through long-term, renewable, and transferable
16		leases or other means that are in accordance with
17		rules adopted by the administration under chapter
18		91; and

1	(B) Revert back to the administration if:	
2	(i) The land is used for any purpose other than	
3	as provided under subparagraph (A); or	
4	(ii) The qualified nonprofit organization ceases	
5	operations.	
6	(b) For the purposes of this section:	
7	"Affordable housing" means housing that is affordable to	
8	households with incomes at or below one hundred forty per cent	
9	of the median family income as determined by the United States	
10	Department of Housing and Urban Development.	
11	"Qualified nonprofit organization" means any private entity	
12	that is organized and operated:	
13	(1) In accordance with Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal	
14	Revenue Code of 1986, as amended; and	
15	(2) For the purpose of providing affordable housing	
16	through long-term, renewable, and transferable	
17	<u>leases."</u>	
18	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.	
19	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
