
# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EMERGENCY RELIEF FOR NATURAL DISASTERS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for 1 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of 2 3 the Hawaii State Constitution. SECTION 2. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds 4 5 to: Cover the costs of recovery and remediation efforts as 6 a result of storms that have occurred in February and 7 March 2006; 8 Stabilize and repair storm-damaged slopes, drainage 9 (2) ways, and drainage systems to restore functionality 10 and prevent future damage; 11 (3) Hire consultants to: 12 Determine the structural integrity of dams and 13 (a) reservoirs statewide; 14 Assess potential immediate risks; and 15 (b) 16 Recommend long-term plans to ensure dam safety; 17 and
