## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO APPELLATE JURISDICTION.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

Section 602-57, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 SECTION 1. 2 amended to read as follows: "S602-57 Jurisdiction. Notwithstanding any other law to 3 the contrary, the intermediate appellate court shall have 4 jurisdiction, subject to transfer as provided in section 602-58 5 or review on application for a writ of certiorari as provided in 6 7 section 602-59: 8 To hear and determine appeals from [the district, 9 family, and circuit courts and from ] any court or agency when appeals are allowed by law; [and] 10 To entertain, in its discretion, any case submitted 11 (2)without suit when there is a question of law that 12 could be the subject of a civil action or proceeding 13 in the circuit court, or tax appeal court, and the 14 parties agree upon the facts upon which the 15 controversy depends [+]; and 16 To make or issue any order or writ necessary or 17 (3)

appropriate in the aid of its jurisdiction, and in
