A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INSURANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 Section 431:2-215, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 3 "(b) Sums from the compliance resolution fund expended by the commissioner shall be used to defray any administrative 4 5 costs, including personnel costs, associated with the programs 6 of the division, and costs incurred by supporting offices and 7 divisions. Any law to the contrary notwithstanding, the 8 commissioner may use the moneys in the fund to employ or retain, 9 by contract or otherwise, without regard to chapter 76, hearings 10 officers, attorneys, investigators, accountants, examiners, and 11 other necessary professional, technical, administrative, and 12 support personnel to implement and carry out the purposes of 13 title 24; provided that any position, except any attorney 14 position, that [is] was subject to chapter 76 prior to July 1, 1999, shall remain subject to chapter 76." 15 16 SECTION 2. Section 431:2-216, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 17 amended by amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows:
