A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHAPTER 448E, HAWAII REVISED STATUTES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- Section 448E-9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended to read as follows: 2 "§448E-9 Unlicensed activity. (a) No person shall act or 3 assume to act as a journey worker electrician, journey worker 4 5 specialty electrician, supervising electrician, supervising specialty electrician, journey worker plumber, master plumber, 6 maintenance electrician, journey worker industrial electrician, 7 or supervising industrial electrician, or advertise or hold the 8 person's self out as an electrician or plumber, without a 9 license previously obtained in compliance with this chapter and 10 11 the rules of the board; provided that any person may perform emergency plumbing repair work in the person's principal place 12 of residence when such repairs do not involve or require 13 rearrangement of valves, pipes, or fixtures; provided further 14 that no such emergency repairs may be performed on sewer lines, 15 drains, gas lines, and on fixtures being served with backflow 16 devices which [includes] include heaters, water closets, 17 dishwashers, and garbage disposal units. 18
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- 1 For purposes of this subsection:
- 2 "Electrician" means any person who performs electrical work
- 3 and includes but is not limited to any person who acts as a
- 4 journey worker electrician, journey worker specialty
- 5 electrician, supervising electrician, supervising specialty
- 6 electrician, maintenance electrician, journey worker industrial
- 7 electrician, or supervising industrial electrician.
- 8 "Plumber" means any person who performs plumbing work and
- 9 includes but is not limited to any person who acts as a journey
- 10 worker plumber or master plumber.
- 11 (b) An apprentice or trainee learning the trade of a
- 12 person licensed under this chapter shall not be required to have
- 13 a license if the apprentice or trainee acts under the
- 14 supervision of a person appropriately licensed under this
- 15 chapter.
- (c) Upon entry of a judgment by a court of competent
- 17 jurisdiction finding that the person has advertised in violation
- 18 of this section, the entity furnishing voice communication
- 19 service to the violator shall disconnect the telephone number
- 20 contained in the advertisement or listing."
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 448E-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 22 amended to read as follows:

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1	"§44	3E-10 Suspension; revocation; fine; denial of issuance
2	or renewa	of a license. (a) In addition to any other actions
3	authorize	d by law the board, after notice and hearing as
4	provided	in chapter 91, may suspend or revoke any license, or
5	impose fi	nes, or prior to the notice and hearing, deny the
6	issuance	or renewal of any license for any cause authorized by
7	law, incl	uding but not limited to the following:
8	(1)	[A license was or is sought to be obtained] Obtaining,
9		or attempting to obtain a license by fraud,
10		misrepresentation, or deceit;
11	(2)	Gross negligence, incompetency, misconduct, or
12		dishonesty in the practice of the profession;
13	(3)	False, fraudulent, or deceptive advertising;
14	(4)	Permitting an unlicensed person to perform activities
15		requiring a license; [or]
16	(5)	Aiding or abetting an unlicensed person to violate
17		this chapter;
18	<u>(6)</u>	Allowing a person's license to be used by an
19		unlicensed person;
20	(7)	Acting as an agent, partner, or associate of an
21		unlicensed person engaging in an activity in violation
22		of this chapter; or

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1	[(5) Violation of] (8) Violating any [provisions] provision
2	of this chapter [and any rules] or rule of the board.
3	(b) Any person who violates any provision of this chapter
4	shall be fined not less than \$100 and not more than $[\$1,000]$
5	\$5,000 for each violation."
6	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
7	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
8	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
