A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHILD ABUSE OR NEGLECT REPORTING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The intent of the legislature is to ensure the
- 2 safety of children through the timely reporting of child abuse
- 3 and neglect.
- 4 The purpose of this bill is to strengthen the child abuse
- 5 reporting statute to ensure that instances of known or suspected
- 6 child abuse or neglect are reported without delay by requiring
- 7 the staff at any public or private school, agency, or
- 8 institution, who observe signs of the abuse or neglect, to
- 9 report the abuse or neglect directly to the department of human
- 10 services or the police. This direct reporting will also ensure
- 11 that the best evidence of abuse or neglect is obtained.
- SECTION 2. Section 350-1.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 13 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- "(b) Whenever a person designated in subsection (a) is a
- 15 member of the staff of any public or private school, agency, or
- 16 institution, that staff member shall immediately report the
- 17 known or suspected child abuse or neglect directly to the
- 18 department or to the police department and also shall

- 1 immediately notify the person in charge $[\tau]$ or a designated
- 2 delegate[, who shall immediately report, or cause reports to be
- 3 mader of the report made in accordance with this chapter."
- 4 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
