A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII HISTORIC PRESERVATION SPECIAL FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- Section 6E-16, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is SECTION 1. 1 amended to read as follows: 2 3 "S6E-16 Hawaii historic preservation special fund. There is established a Hawaii historic preservation special fund 4 into which shall be deposited the following moneys: 5 Appropriations by the legislature to the special fund; (1)6 Gifts, donations, and grants from public agencies and 7 (2)private persons; [and] 8 All proceeds collected by the department derived from 9 (3)historic preserve user fees, historic preserve leases 10 or concession fees, fees charged to carry out the 11 purposes of this chapter, or the sale of goods [-]; and 12 Civil, criminal, and administrative penalties, fines, 13 (4)and other charges collected under this chapter or any 14 rule adopted pursuant to this chapter. 15 All interest earned or accrued on moneys deposited in the fund 16 shall become part of the fund. - 8 (4) To provide financial assistance to public agencies and
- private agencies in accordance with chapter [42D] 42F

- than those covered by section 6E-9[+]; and
- 12 <u>(5)</u> To cover administrative and operational costs of the
- historic preservation program.
- 14 (c) The department shall adopt rules in accordance with
- 15 chapter 91 for the purposes of this section."
- 16 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
