## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CRUELTY TO ANIMALS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 711-1110.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended to	o read as follows:
3	"[ <del>{</del> ]:	§711-1110.5[] Surrender or forfeiture of animals.
4	Upon conv	iction, guilty plea, or plea of nolo contendere for any
5	violation	of section 711-1109 or 711-1109.3:
6	(1)	The court may order the defendant to surrender or
7		forfeit the animal whose treatment was the basis of
8		the conviction or plea to the custody of a duly
9		incorporated humane society or <u>duly incorporated</u>
10		society for the prevention of cruelty to animals for
11		[such] the time and under [such] the conditions as the
12		court shall order[-]; and
13	(2)	The court also may order the defendant to surrender or
14		forfeit any other animals under the possession,
15		custody, or control of the defendant to the custody of
16		a duly incorporated humane society or <u>duly</u>
17		incorporated society for the prevention of cruelty to
18		animals for [such a] the time and under [such] the

1	conditions as the court shall order, if there is		
2	substantial evidence that [such] the animals are being		
3	abused or neglected.		
4	The court shall order the defendant to reimburse the duly		
5	incorporated humane society or duly incorporated society for the		
6	prevention of cruelty to animals for reasonable costs incurred		
7	to care, feed, and house any animal that is surrendered or		
8	forfeited pursuant to this section."		
9	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that		
10	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were		
11	begun, before its effective date.		
12	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed		
13	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.		
14	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
