A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE BONDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 Declaration of findings with respect to the SECTION 1. general obligation bonds authorized by this Act. Pursuant to 2 the clause in Article VII, Section 13 of the State Constitution 3 which states: "Effective July 1, 1980, the legislature shall 4 include a declaration of findings in every general law 5 authorizing the issuance of general obligation bonds that the 6 total amount of principal and interest, estimated for such bonds 7 and for all bonds authorized and unissued and calculated for all 8 bonds issued and outstanding, will not cause the debt limit to 9 be exceeded at the time of issuance," the legislature finds and 10 declares as follows: 11 (1) Limitation on general obligation debt. The debt limit 12 13

of the state is set forth in Article VII, Section 13
of the State Constitution, which states in part:

"General obligation bonds may be issued by the State;
provided that such bonds at the time of issuance would
not cause the total amount of principal and interest
payable in the current or any future fiscal year,

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- 1 be required to refund any general obligation bonds of the State
- 2 of Hawaii heretofore or hereafter issued pursuant to law.
- 3 SECTION 4. The provisions of this Act are declared to be
- 4 severable and if any portion thereof is held to be invalid for
- 5 any reason, the validity of the remainder of this Act shall not
- 6 be affected.
- 7 SECTION 5. In printing this Act, the revisor of statutes
- 8 shall substitute in section 1 and section 3 the corresponding
- 9 act numbers for bills identified therein.
- 10 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
