# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ENDANGERING THE WELFARE OF A MINOR.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 709-903.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows: 2 "(1) Except as provided in subsection (2), a person 3 commits the offense of endangering the welfare of a minor in the 4 first degree if, having care or custody of a minor, the person 5 [intentionally]: 6 Intentionally or knowingly allows another person to 7 (a) inflict serious or substantial bodily injury on the 8 minor[-]; or Intentionally or knowingly causes or permits the minor 10 (b) to ingest methamphetamine." 11 SECTION 2. Section 709-904, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 12 amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows: 13 "(1) Except as provided in section 709-903.5(2), a person 14 commits the offense of endangering the welfare of a minor in the 15 second degree if, having care or custody of a minor, the person 16 17 [recklessly]:
