A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PLANNED COMMUNITY ASSOCIATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Section 508D-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended by amending the definition of "disclosure statement" to 3 read as follows: ""Disclosure statement" means a written statement prepared 4 by the seller, or at the seller's direction, that purports to 5 fully and accurately disclose all material facts relating to the 6 residential real property being offered for sale that: 7 Are within the knowledge or control of the seller; 8 (2) Can be observed from visible, accessible areas; or 9 (3) Are required to be disclosed under sections [508D-15] 10 11 508D-4.5 and [508D-4.5] 508D-15. If the residential real property being offered for sale is in a 12 planned community, "disclosure statement" includes the planned 13 community declaration and association documents as those terms 14 are defined in section 421J-2. Except for the disclosures 15 required under section 508D-15, no seller shall have any duty to 16 examine any public records when preparing a disclosure 17

- 2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 3 begun, before its effective date.
- 4 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
