A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HIGH TECHNOLOGY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that, in 1989, the legislature created the Hawaii small business innovation 2 research grant program under chapter 206M-15, Hawaii Revised 3 Statutes. Prior to 1989, there were two Hawaii small business 4 5 innovation research grant program-awarded companies, but since 6 1989, fifty-six Hawaii companies have won two hundred forty-five 7 small business innovation research grant program awards. These grant program awards brought approximately \$56,500,000 in 8 9 federal small business innovation research grant program Phase I and Phase II funds to Hawaii. In addition to these grants, 10 \$57,500,000 in Phase III small business innovation research 11 12 grant program commercialization contracts have been awarded to Hawaii companies. According to the United States Department of 13 14 Agriculture, Hawaii companies have won the highest number of United States Department of Agriculture small business 15 innovation research grant program awards per capita of any 16
