A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ADULT FOSTER CARE HOMES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 Section 321-11.2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is SECTION 1. 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 The department of health is authorized to certify adult foster homes for developmentally disabled individuals 4 5 requiring such care beyond the eighteenth birthday. "Adult 6 foster home" means a private home providing care on a twentyfour hour basis for adults with developmental disabilities. To 7 be certified, an adult foster home shall have not more than 8 [two] three adults with developmental disabilities at the same 9 10 time, who are unrelated to the foster family. To accommodate residents of a foster boarding home for children with 11 developmental disabilities who reach the age of eighteen years, 12 where the home is certified as a foster boarding home for 13 children under section 346-17, the director of health may waive 14 the [two] three adult limit for certification of that home as an 15 16 adult foster home, provided that: [the] The number of foster children and adults in such 17 (1)
