A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THEFT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

15		displayed on the premises a sign or signs sufficient
16		to give notice and reading as follows: "Private
17		Property"; or

1 [(d)] (e) Of agricultural equipment, supplies, or products, 2 or part thereof, the value of which exceeds \$100 but 3 does not exceed \$20,000, or of agricultural products 4 that exceed twenty-five pounds, from premises that are fenced, enclosed, or secured in a manner designed to 5 6 exclude intruders or there is prominently displayed on 7 the premises a sign or signs sufficient to give notice 8 and reading as follows: "Private Property." The sign or signs, containing letters not less than two inches 9 10 in height, shall be placed along the boundary line of the land in a manner and in such position as to be 11 12 clearly noticeable from outside the boundary line. Possession of agricultural products without ownership 13 and movement certificates, when a certificate is 14 required pursuant to chapter 145, is prima facie 15 16 evidence that the products are or have been stolen. Theft in the second degree is a class C felony. A **17** (2)

(2) Theft in the second degree is a class C felony. A person convicted of committing the offense of theft in the second degree under [(c) and (d)] subsection (1)(d) or (e) shall be sentenced in accordance with chapter 706, except that for the first offense, the court may impose a minimum sentence of a fine

- 1 of at least \$1,000 or two-fold damages sustained by the victim,
- 2 whichever is greater."
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 5 begun, before its effective date.
- 6 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2020.
