## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HARBORS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that maritime lands are a 1 finite resource of the state. In particular, Honolulu harbor 2 Piers 1 and 2 contain vital and unique maritime cargo facilities 3 that cannot be easily relocated. Any relocation of these 4 facilities would be prohibitively expensive. Piers 1 and 2 and 5 the contiguous backup fast lands and access roads, comprising 6 approximately twenty-one acres, must be protected and preserved 7 to provide for an expansion area consistent with the predicted 8 growth of future cargo requirements and to permit for the safe 9 and efficient berthing of major cargo vessels. Projections made 10 by the department of transportation, harbors division, indicate 11 that foreign cargo capacity will be exhausted within five years 12 at the present rate of growth. 13 Piers 1 and 2 are currently used for cargo yard storage 14 space. This area is expected to decrease by approximately five 15 acres with the development of part of Pier 2 as a passenger 16

cruise ship terminal.

    the Forrest Avenue subdivision and parcels 2, 3-A, A, and B as

    shown on the map filed with the bureau of conveyances of the

    State of Hawaii, as file plan 2335; lots A-1 and A-2, as shown

    on map 2, filed in the office of the assistant registrar of the

community development district boundaries shall not be affected 1 by this change." 2 SECTION 3. Section 206E-32, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 3 amended to read as follows: 4 "\$206E-32 District; established, boundaries. The Kakaako 5 community development district is established. The district 6 shall include that area bounded by King Street; Piikoi Street 7 from its intersection with King Street to Ala Moana Boulevard; 8 Ala Moana Boulevard, inclusive, from Piikoi Street to its 9 intersection with the Ewa boundary of Ala Moana Park also 10 identified as the Ewa boundary of tax map key 2-3-37:01; the Ewa 11 boundary of tax map key 2-3-37:01 from its intersection with Ala 12 Moana Boulevard to the shoreline; the shoreline from its 13 intersection with the property line representing the Ewa 14 boundary of property identified by tax map key 2-3-37:01 to the 15 property line between Pier 2 and Pier 4; the property line 16 between Pier 2 and Pier 4 from its intersection with the 17 shoreline to Ala Moana Boulevard; Ala Moana Boulevard from its 18 intersection with the property line between lands identified by 19 Pier 2 and Pier 4 to Punchbowl Street; and Punchbowl Street to 20 its intersection with King Street [-]; provided that the 21

following parcels at Piers 1 and 2 shall be deleted from the

Kakaako community development district boundaries and conveyed 1 to the department of land and natural resources to be set aside 2 for the department of transportation and the foreign trade zone 3 division of the department of business, economic development, 4 and tourism, to ensure continued maritime and foreign commerce 5 use: all of lot 3 of the Forrest Avenue subdivision and parcels 6 2, 3-A, A, and B as shown on the map filed with the bureau of 7 conveyances of the State of Hawaii, as file plan 2335; lots A-1 8 and A-2, as shown on map 2, filed in the office of the assistant 9 registrar of the land court of the State of Hawaii with land 10 court application 1328; and provided further that all existing 11 easements affecting and appurtenant to the parcels to be deleted 12 from the Kakaako community development district boundaries shall 13 not be affected by this change. 14 The district shall also include that parcel of land 15 identified by tax map key 2-1-14:16, situated mauka of Pier 6 16 and Pier 7 and makai of Nimitz Highway, being the site for the 17 existing Hawaiian Electric power plant and related facilities." 18 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 19 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 20

SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
