A BILL FOR AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 711-1109, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended by amending subsections (1) and (2) to read as follows: 2 "(1) A person commits the offense of cruelty to animals if 3 the person intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly: 4 Overdrives, overloads, tortures, torments, cruelly 5 (a) beats, or starves any animal, or causes or procures 6 the overdriving, overloading, torture, torment, cruel beating, or starving of any animal, or deprives a pet animal of necessary sustenance or causes such 9 deprivation; 10 Mutilates, poisons, or kills without need any animal 11 (b) other than insects, vermin, or other pests; 12 Keeps, uses, or in any way is connected with or 13 (c) interested in the management of, or receives money for 14 the admission of any person to, any place kept or used 15 for the purpose of fighting or baiting any bull, bear, 16 dog, cock, or other animal, and every person who 17
