A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 431, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to article 10C, to be 3 appropriately designated and to read as follows: 4 "\$431:10C- Exclusion of designated persons. (a) An 5 insurer may exclude from coverage under a motor vehicle 6 insurance policy, any person operating the motor vehicle and 7 specifically designated or excluded by the insurer. Any such 8 exclusion shall be acknowledged by the signature of the primary 9 named insured. The written agreement between an insurer and the 10 primary named insured shall be effective for each renewal of the 11 policy by an insurer and shall remain in effect until the 12 insurer and primary named insured agree in writing to provide 13 coverage for the person or persons who were previously excluded 14 from coverage. 15 (b) Endorsements shall be substantially similar to the
