BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 281, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

4	" <u>§281-</u> Direct shipment of wine by wineries. (a) Any

11	(B) A license to manufacture wine issued by another

13	may pay any applicable fees and obtain a direct wine shipper			
14	permit from the liquor commission of the county where the wine			
15	will be shipped authorizing the holder to directly ship wine to			
16	persons in the county pursuant to this section.			
17	(b) The holder of a direct wine shipper permit may sell
