A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that there is a lack of
- 2 hospitals and health centers in the southern portion of the
- 3 island of Hawaii, and residents of the area are particularly
- 4 vulnerable in the event of a serious medical emergency. The
- 5 most efficient solution is to provide two emergency mobile
- 6 urgent care units to be stationed at the fire departments in the
- 7 communities of Ocean View and Volcano.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to provide
- 9 the people of the southern portion of the island of Hawaii with
- 10 access to appropriate emergency and urgent medical care.
- 11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 13 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 to be used
- 14 for two emergency mobile urgent care units to be stationed at
- 15 the fire departments of the Ocean View and Volcano communities
- 16 on the island of Hawaii.

- 1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the county of
- 2 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
