BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 444-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended t	o read as follows:
3	"§44	4-2 Exemptions. This chapter shall not apply to:
4	(1)	Officers and employees of the United States, the
5		State, or any county while in the performance of their
6		governmental duties;
7	(2)	Any person acting as a receiver, trustee in
8		bankruptcy, personal representative, or any other
9		person acting under any order or authorization of any
10		court;
11	(3)	A person who sells or installs any finished products,
12		materials, or articles of merchandise that are not
13		actually fabricated into and do not become a permanent
14		fixed part of the structure, or to the construction,
15		alteration, improvement, or repair of personal
16		property;
17	(4)	Any project or operation for which the aggregate
18		contract price for labor, materials, taxes, and all

1		othe	r items is not more than $[\$1,000.]$ $\$$. This
2		exem	ption shall not apply in any case where [a]:

21		resi	dential, farm, industrial, or commercial buildings
22		or s	tructures on property for their own use, or for

use by their grandparents, parents, siblings, or
children and who do not offer the buildings or
structures for sale or lease; provided that this
exemption shall not apply to electrical or plumbing
work that must be performed only by persons or
entities licensed under this chapter, or to the owner
or lessee of the property if the owner or lessee is
licensed under chapter 448E. In all actions brought
under this paragraph, proof of the sale or lease, or
offering for sale or lease, of the structure not more
than one year after completion is prima facie evidence
that the construction or improvement of the structure
was undertaken for the purpose of sale or lease;
provided that this provision shall not apply to
residential properties sold or leased to employees of
the owner or lessee; provided further that [in order]
to qualify for this exemption the owner or lessee must
register for the exemptions as provided in section
444-9.1. Any owner or lessee of property found to
have violated this paragraph shall not be permitted to
engage in any activities pursuant to this paragraph or
to register under section 444-9.1 for a period of

1		three years. There is a presumption that an owner or
2		lessee has violated this section, when the owner or
3		lessee obtains an exemption from the licensing
4		requirements of section 444-9 more than once in two
5		years;
6	(8)	Any joint venture if all members thereof hold licenses
7		issued under this chapter;
8	(9)	Any project or operation where it is determined by the
9		board that less than ten persons are qualified to
10		perform the work in question and that the work does
11		not pose a potential danger to public health, safety,
12		and welfare; or
13	(10)	Any public works project that requires additional
14		qualifications beyond those established by the
15		licensing law and which is deemed necessary and in the
16		public interest by the contracting agency."

19	SECT	ION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
