BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 291-14, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 3 "(c) No operator of any pickup truck may operate the
- 4 vehicle with any passenger [twelve] eighteen years of age or
- 5 under in the bed or load-carrying area of the vehicle, unless
- 6 one of the following applies:
- 7 (1) An emergency exists that threatens the life of the
- 8 passenger being transported in the bed or load-
- 9 carrying area of the vehicle; or
- 10 (2) The vehicle is being operated in parades, caravans, or
- 11 exhibitions which are officially authorized or
- otherwise permitted by law."
- 13 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2007.
