A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE DRUG NUISANCE ABATEMENT UNIT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 The legislature finds that the Drug Nuisance 2 Abatement Unit was established in the Attorney General's office 3 pursuant to Act 63, Session Laws of Hawaii 2003 to provide for 4 enforcement and prosecution of nuisance abatement laws as a way 5 of combating the rampant growth of "ice" houses in the communities of the state. The legislature further finds that 6 7 while the General Appropriations Act of 2005 appropriated \$150,000 in general funds to finance the unit for fiscal year 8 2005-2006, no funding was appropriated for fiscal year 2006-9
- 12 report by the unit outlining priorities and projected
 13 expenditures, and unit performance. The report validates the
 14 wisdom of the legislature to support this program as a means to
 15 combat "ice" houses, but also shows the limitations of the
 16 program due to funding constraints. The report cites the need
 17 for an additional Investigator VI and one half-time Investigator
- 18 V to reduce the case backlog. Additionally, the report states
