## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE SENATOR OREN E. LONG SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Senator Hiram L.
- 2 Fong's legislative accomplishments in the United States Senate,
- 3 which enabled Hawaii to become a full and sovereign federal
- 4 state with the other forty-nine, owed greatly to the
- 5 collaboration and cooperation of his colleagues, particularly
- 6 the other Senator from Hawaii, Oren E. Long, and Senator Lyndon
- 7 B. Johnson, then Senate Majority Leader. Senator Long, with
- 8 Senator Fong and forty-eight other sponsors, introduced Senate
- 9 Bill 3395, which established the East-West Center. Senator Long
- 10 gave forty-one years of public service to Hawaii, as a public
- 11 school teacher and principal, rising to Superintendent of Public
- 12 Instruction (1934-46), Secretary of the Territory of Hawaii
- 13 (1946-51), and then Governor of Hawaii (1951-53). Elected to
- 14 the United States Senate in 1959, he served until 1963 and died
- 15 in 1965, without any children or family in Hawaii. The
- 16 legislature intends to honor, recognize, and perpetuate the
- 17 memory of Senator Oren E. Long's lifelong contributions to the
- 18 people of Hawaii by establishing and endowing a scholarship in



- his name and in his chosen profession of education at the
  University of Hawaii.
- 3 The purpose of this Act is to establish the Senator Oren E.
- 4 Long scholarship program.
- 5 SECTION 2. Chapter 304, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 6 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 7 and to read as follows:
- 8 "§304- The Senator Oren E. Long scholarship program;
- 9 special fund. (a) There is created the Senator Oren E. Long
- 10 scholarship program to be administered by the University of
- 11 Hawaii. The program shall be used to provide financial support
- 12 to students enrolled in a state-approved teacher preparation
- 13 program at the University of Hawaii.
- 14 (b) Awards shall be granted annually to one female student
- 15 and one male student who:
- 16 (1) Are residents of Hawaii;
- 17 (2) Are graduates of a public high school in the state;
- 18 (3) Are enrolled in a state-approved teacher preparation
- 19 program at the University of Hawaii; and
- 20 (4) Submit an essay on the senator's contributions to
- Hawaii.

1	<u>(c)</u>	The amount to be awarded to a student shall be
2	determine	d by the board of regents with due regard to the total
3	amount of	funds available for the program. The award that a
4 ,	student r	eceives under this program may be used to:
5	(1)	Pay for the costs of tuition and fees;
6	(2)	Pay for the costs of textbooks and other instructional
7		<pre>materials;</pre>
8	(3)	Pay for costs of room and board at a dormitory or
9		apartment maintained by the University of Hawaii; or
10	(4)	Defray the difference between the student need, as
11		determined by the Free Application for Federal Student
12		Aid, and the total cost of attendance.
13	(d)	The board of regents shall adopt rules to implement
14	the Senator Oren E. Long scholarship program. The rules shall	
15	be adopted pursuant to chapter 91, but shall be exempt from the	
16	public notice and public hearing requirements.	
17	(e)	The funds for this scholarship program shall be
18	deposited	into the student scholarship and assistance special
19	fund and shall be administered by the board of regents of the	
20	University of Hawaii for the purposes of supporting the Senator	
21	Oren E. Long scholarship program."	

- 1 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$200,000 or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 to be
- 4 deposited into the student scholarship and assistance special
- 5 fund.
- 6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 7 budget and finance for the purposes of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the student
- 9 scholarship and assistance special fund the sum of \$200,000 or
- 10 so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 to
- 11 be used for the Senator Oren E. Long scholarship program.
- 12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the University of
- 13 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.
- 14 SECTION 5. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
