### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FLAVORED TOBACCO PRODUCTS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that there has been a 1 proliferation of flavored tobacco products in recent years. 2 Many of these products have fruit, chocolate, honey, candy, 3 4 mint, cocoa, dessert, herb, spice, or other flavors that are particularly attractive to children. According to public health 5 experts, children are more likely to choose flavored tobacco 6 when they start smoking or use other tobacco products, in part, 7 because the product names for flavored tobacco products are 8 similar to product names for candy, drinks, and other products 9 10 marketed directly to children. The legislature further finds that the existence of these 11 12 products increases the incidence of tobacco use among children and that the earlier that an individual begins using tobacco 13 products, the more likely he or she will become addicted to and 14 use them throughout his or her lifetime. As a result, flavored 15 tobacco products result in increased tobacco use, increased 16 addiction, a greater incidence of smoking and other tobacco-17

related illnesses and deaths, and increased health care costs.

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# H.B. NO. 2048

1 The purpose of this Act is to prohibit the sale and distribution of flavored tobacco products because the 2 legislature finds that tobacco flavorings present a significant 3 4 threat to public health. SECTION 2. The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by 5 adding a new chapter to be appropriately designated and to read 6 7 as follows: "CHAPTER 8 FLAVORED TOBACCO PRODUCTS 9 § -1 Definitions. As used in this part, unless the 10 context otherwise requires, the terms: 11 "Characterizing flavor" means a distinguishable taste or 12 aroma, other than tobacco, menthol, or clove, imparted either 13 14 prior to or during consumption. "Chewing tobacco" means loose tobacco or a flat compressed 15 cake of tobacco a portion of which is inserted into the mouth. 16 "Component parts" includes, but is not limited to, the 17 tobacco, filter, and paper in a cigarette or cigar. 18

"Constituent" includes a smoke constituent.

"Smokeless tobacco" means chewing tobacco or tobacco snuff.

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"Tobacco snuff" means a small amount of shredded, powdered, 1 or pulverized tobacco that may be inhaled through the nostrils, 2 chewed, or held in the mouth of an individual user. 3 -2 Prohibition. No person shall sell, offer for sale, 4 or distribute in this State or to any person in this State any 5 cigarette, cigar, smokeless tobacco product or any component 6 part thereof containing a natural or artificial constituent or 7 additive that causes the cigarette, cigar, or smokeless tobacco 8 product to have a characterizing flavor. 9 -3 Remedies. The attorney general may institute a 10 civil action in the name of the State in the circuit court for 11 an injunction prohibiting a violation of this section. 12 court, upon notice to the defendant in compliance with the 13 Hawaii rules of civil procedure, and upon proof that the 14 defendant has violated this section, may enjoin further sale or 15 distribution by the defendant. The court may impose a civil 16 penalty in an amount not to exceed \$5,000 for each violation. 17 The attorney general may recover costs and disbursements, 18 including costs of investigation and reasonable attorney fees. 19 Nothing in this section precludes the State or any other person 20 from pursuing any other claims, remedies, or actions available 21

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by law."

- SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that 1
- matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- begun, before its effective date. 3
- SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2007. 4
