BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to allow inmates
- under the jurisdiction of the department of public safety to use 2
- 3 pre-paid phone cards to make phone calls.
- SECTION 2. Chapter 353, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 4
- amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 5
- and to read as follows: 6
- "§353- Access to pre-paid phone cards. The director 7
- shall allow access to pre-paid phone cards for use by inmates 8
- under the jurisdiction of the department to make local and long-9
- distance phone calls. The pre-paid phone cards shall be made 10
- available to pre-trial detainees and convicted offenders housed 11
- at Hawaii correctional facilities and out-of-state contracted 12
- facilities. The inmate's family members may provide the pre-13
- paid phone cards. "Family members" means persons who are 14
- related to each other by blood, marriage, adoption, or legal 15
- 16 guardianship.
- 17 The department shall develop policies and procedures to
- minimize any security risk associated with the phone cards. 18
