## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature recognizes the rich ethnic and cultural diversity of our island State. As such, there should 2 3 be an opportunity to honor religious and cultural practices 4 associated with childbirth. There must, at the same time, be 5 due consideration for proper assurances of public health and 6 safety. 7 SECTION 2. Chapter 321, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 8 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 9 and to read as follows: 10 "§321-Human placenta. Upon negative findings of 11 infection or hazard after appropriate testing of the mother, the 12 human placenta may be released by the hospital to the woman from 13 whom it originated or to the woman's designee. The department shall establish a release form which shall stipulate appropriate 14 15 measures for the safe release of human placenta." 16 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
