## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOMELESSNESS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 201G, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section in part IV to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "S201G- Temporary emergency housing. (a) In addition
- 5 to any other duties prescribed by law, the administration shall
- 6 coordinate with the four counties a procedure for identifying
- 7 locations that shall be used for temporary emergency shelters
- 8 for homeless individuals and families.
- 9 (b) Each county shall be responsible for locating,
- 10 designating, and maintaining the areas that shall be used for
- 11 temporary emergency shelters. The designated locations may
- 12 include public parks or established homeless facilities.
- (c) The administration shall submit an annual report to
- 14 the legislature detailing the activities and outcomes under this
- 15 section no later than twenty days prior to the convening of each
- 16 regular session."
- 17 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 18 revenues of the State of Hawaii the following sums or so much

thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 to assist 1 2 the counties in implementing this Act: City and county of Honolulu \$ 3 \$ County of Kauai 4 \$ County of Maui 5 \$ 6 County of Hawaii \$ 7 Total The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department 8 of budget and finance for the purposes of this Act. 9 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated shall constitute the 10 State's share of the cost of mandated programs under Article 11 VIII, Section 5, of the State Constitution. 12 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored. 13 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020; 14 provided that sections 2 and 3 shall take effect on July 1, 15
