## A BILL FOR AN ACT

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 709, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 2 3 and to read as follows: 4 Leaving a child locked in a building or vehicle. "§709-(a) A person commits the offense of leaving a child locked in a 5 building or vehicle if, having care or custody of a child under 6 the age of eight years, the person intentionally or knowingly 7 allows the child to be locked or confined in a dwelling, 8 building or enclosure, or motor vehicle while the person is 9 absent and the dwelling, building or enclosure, or motor vehicle 10 is out of sight of the person, unless the person provides a 11 reliable person at least thirteen years old to remain with and 12 protect the child. 13 (b) Leaving a child locked in a building or vehicle is a 14 15 misdemeanor." SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that 16
