A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC LANDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 171-13, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended to read as follows:
3	"§171-13 Disposition of public lands[-]; prior approval by
4	<u>legislature.</u> (a) Except as otherwise provided by law and
5	subject to other provisions of this chapter, the board may:
6	(1) Dispose of public land in fee simple, by lease, lease
7	with option to purchase, license, or permit; and
8	(2) Grant easement by direct negotiation or otherwise for
9	particular purposes in perpetuity on such terms as may
10	be set by the board, subject to reverter to the State
11	upon termination or abandonment of the specific
12	purpose for which it was granted, provided the sale
13	price of such easement shall be determined pursuant to
14	section 171-17(b).
15	(b) No person shall be eligible to purchase or lease
16	public lands, or to be granted a license, permit, or easement
17	covering public lands, who has had during the five years
18	preceding the date of disposition a previous sale, lease,

license, permit, or easement covering public lands cancelled for 1 failure to satisfy the terms and conditions thereof. 2 (c) Any disposition of public lands in fee simple, by 3 lease with option to purchase, or grant of easement in 4 perpetuity shall be subject to the prior approval of the 5 legislature by concurrent resolution. The department shall 6 submit for introduction to the legislature a resolution for 7 review of action on any proposed disposition in fee simple, by 8 lease with option to purchase, or grant of easement in 9 perpetuity to be consummated by the board wherein deeds, leases, 10 or grants will be executed by the parties together with the 11 following information: 12 The location and area of the parcel of land to be 13 (1) 14 disposed of; The appraised value of the land to be disposed of; (2)15 The name of the real estate appraiser that appraised (3) 16 the land to be disposed of; 17 The name of the proposed grantee or lessee; and 18 (4)Copies of the dispositive documents. 19 (5) This subsection shall not apply to dispositions in fee simple, 20 by lease with option to purchase, or grant of easement in 21

perpetuity of any remnant or grant to any state or county

department or agency for roadway or infrastructure 1 improvements." 2 SECTION 2. Chapter 206E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 3 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 4 and to read as follows: 5 "\$206E- Disposition of property, prior approval by 6 legislature. (a) Any disposition of lands by the authority in 7 fee simple, by lease with option to purchase, or grant of 8 easement in perpetuity shall be subject to the prior approval of 9 the legislature by concurrent resolution. The authority shall 10 submit for introduction to the legislature a resolution for 11 review of action on any proposed disposition in fee simple, by 12 lease with option to purchase, or grant of easement in 13 perpetuity to be consummated by the authority wherein deeds, 14 leases, or grants will be executed by the parties together with 15 the following information: 16 The location and area of the parcel of land to be 17 (1)disposed of; 18 The appraised value of the land to be disposed of; 19 (2) The name of the real estate appraiser that appraised 20 (3) the land to be disposed of; 21 The name of the proposed grantee or lessee; and

- 1 (5) Copies of the dispositive documents.
- 2 (b) This section shall not apply to any disposition of
- 3 land in fee simple, by lease with option to purchase, or grant
- 4 of easement in perpetuity of a remnant, as defined in section
- 5 171-52, or a grant to any state or county department or agency
- 6 for roadway or infrastructure improvements."
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 8 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 9 begun, before its effective date.
- 10 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
