A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds
- 2 to establish a rapid response emergency medical services unit,
- 3 to include personnel, equipment, and operational expenses for a
- 4 twenty-four hour, seven days a week, rapid response emergency
- 5 medical services unit for the Mililani/Mililani Mauka area on
- 6 Oahu.
- 7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$600,000, or so much
- 9 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, to be
- 10 deposited into the emergency medical services special fund.
- 11 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the emergency
- 12 medical services special fund the sum of \$600,000, or so much
- 13 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, to
- 14 establish a twenty-four hour, seven days a week, rapid response
- 15 emergency medical services unit to serve the Mililani/Mililani
- 16 Mauka area on Oahu.
- 17 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 18 health for the purpose of this Act.

SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
