## A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds 1 for a fully-capable, advanced life support emergency medical 2 services ambulance unit that would provide sixteen-hours-a-day, 3 seven-days-a-week emergency response service to the areas of 4 Lower Mililani, Waipio Gentry, Waikele, Crestview, East Waipahu, 5 Waiawa, and the Pearl City industrial area on Oahu. 6 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 7 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,300,000 or so much 8 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 to be 9 deposited into the emergency medical services special fund. 10 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the emergency 11 medical services special fund the sum of \$1 or so much thereof 12 as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 to establish a 13
- 14 fully-capable, advanced life support emergency medical services
- 15 ambulance unit that would provide sixteen-hours-a-day, seven-
- 16 days-a-week emergency response service to the areas of Lower
- 17 Mililani, Waipio Gentry, Waikele, Crestview, East Waipahu,
- 18 Waiawa, and the Pearl City industrial area on Oahu.

- 1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 2 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
