## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 200-19, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows:
3	"(d) The board may execute capital advancement contracts
4	pursuant to subsection (a) with a total contract value of
5	[\$2,000,000] or less without legislative approval.
6	If the total value of a capital advancement contract pursuant to
7	subsection (a) is greater than $[\$2,000,000]$ , then the
8	board shall obtain legislative approval in the form of the
9	adoption of a concurrent resolution affirming the purpose,
10	project, and contract issuance prior to executing the capital
11	advancement contract. The total aggregate value of all capital
12	advancement contracts entered into by the board pursuant to this
13	section shall not exceed [ $\$5,000,000$ ] $\$25,000,000$ in any
14	calendar year."
15	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
16	and stricken New statutory material is underscored

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
