A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 37, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended 1 by adding a new section to part III to be appropriately 2 designated and to read as follows: 3 Positions funded through the expenditure of "§37-4 special fund moneys; legislative authorization required. 5 Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, no program or agency 6 shall transfer personnel or positions exempt from chapter 76, or 7 expend moneys from any special fund appropriated therefor, for 8 9 any purpose other than: The purpose for which the personnel were originally 10 11 hired; The purpose for which the position was established by 12 (2) the legislature; or 13 The purpose for which the special fund moneys were 14 (3) 15 appropriated; without explicit legislative authorization; provided that this 16 section shall not apply to the University of Hawaii or the 17 department of education." 18



SECTION 2. Section 37-74, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows: 2 "(d) No appropriation transfers or changes between 3 programs or agencies shall be made without legislative 4 authorization; provided that: 5 Authorized transfers or changes, when made, shall be (1)6 reported to the legislature; 7 Except with respect to appropriations to fund (2) 8 financing agreements under chapter 37D, the University 9 of Hawaii shall have the flexibility to transfer 10 appropriated funds and positions for the operating 11 cost category among programs, among cost elements in a 12 program, and between quarters, as applicable; except 13 with respect to appropriations to fund financing 14 agreements under chapter 37D, the department of 15 education shall have the flexibility to transfer 16 appropriated funds and positions for the operating 17 cost category among programs and among cost elements 18 in a program, and between quarters, as applicable; and

the Hawaii health systems corporation shall have the

flexibility to transfer special fund appropriations

among community hospitals facilities as applicable;

- 20 to federally funded positions that, if not established, would
- 21 impair the State's ability to receive federal funds in excess of
