### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL WATER RESOURCES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that agriculture is a
- 2 vital component of Hawaii's economy. It provides Hawaii with a
- 3 stage for tourism, export products, a diversity of employment
- 4 opportunities, a lifestyle for its residents, and stewardship
- 5 for its lands and water.
- 6 Therefore, the legislature finds that it is critical for
- 7 the State to determine prioritization criteria for the
- 8 maintenance of natural agricultural water systems to ensure the
- 9 availability of economical water resources for Hawaii's
- 10 agriculture.
- 11 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate the necessary
- 12 funds for fiscal year 2006-2007 for the development of criteria
- 13 for the prioritization of maintaining natural watercourses for
- 14 agricultural use.
- 15 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$300,000 or so much
- 17 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 to study
- 18 important natural water resources used for agricultural
