## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HUNTING.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that, under current law, 1 Hawaii residents sixty-five years of age or older are exempt 2 from payment of fees for a state hunting license. However, 3 under the administrative rules of the department of land and 4 natural resources, division of forestry and wildlife, a fee of 5 6 \$10 is assessed for special or lottery hunts. The purpose of this Act is to provide an exemption from 7 special or lottery hunt fees provided that the individual also 8 qualifies for a free hunting license. 9 SECTION 2. Section 183D-22, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 10 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 11 A hunting license shall be issued to a person by an 12 agent of the department upon: 13 Written application in the form prescribed by the 14 (1)department; 15 Payment of a hunting license fee or any other hunting 16 (2) related fee the board may require as provided in this 17
