A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CARE HOMES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that, although the cost 1 of care has risen, payments from the State for individuals in 2 adult residential care homes have not increased since 1997. The 3 purpose of this Act is to increase the level of payment so that 4 adult residential home operators may be assisted in dealing with 5 increased care costs. 6 SECTION 2. Section 346-53, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 7 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows: 8 The director, pursuant to chapter 91, shall determine 9 the rate of payment for domiciliary care provided to recipients 10 eligible either for Federal Supplementary Security Income, or 11 public assistance in accordance with state standards, or both. 12 The director shall provide for level of care payment as follows: 13 For those adult residential care homes classified as 14 (1)facility type I, licensed developmental disabilities 15 domiciliary homes as defined under section 321-15.9, 16 and adult foster homes as defined under section 17 321-11.2, the state supplemental payment shall [not

1		exceed \$521.90; be an amount as specified in the
2		Hawaii administrative rules but shall not be less than
3		\$621.90; and
4	(2)	For those adult residential care homes classified as
5		facility type II, the state supplemental payment shall
6		[not exceed \$629.90.] be an amount as specified in the
7,		Hawaii administrative rules but shall not be less than
8		\$729.90.
9	If the operator does not provide the quality of care	
10	consistent with the needs of the individual to the satisfaction	
11	of the department, the department may remove the recipient to	
12	another facility.	
13	The department shall handle abusive practices under this	
14	section in accordance with chapter 91.	
15	Nothing in this subsection allows the director to remove a	
16	recipient from an adult residential care home or other similar	
17	institution if the recipient does not desire to be removed and	
18	the operator is agreeable to the recipient remaining, except	
19	where the recipient requires a higher level of care than	
20	provided, or where the recipient no longer requires any	
21	domiciliary care."	

- 1 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, for the
- 4 increase in the level of payments for adult residential care
- 5 homes pursuant to this Act.
- 6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 7 human services for the purposes of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
