A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LAND ACQUISITION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. In its final report dated January 2006, the 1 joint legislative housing and homeless task force (task force) 2 expressed concern that the inventory of affordable housing 3 rental units may be reduced. Affordable rental housing projects 4 built in part with government subsidies have been offered for 5 sale at market prices as a result of the expiration of income 6 and conveyance restrictions encumbered on the property. The 7 task force is committed to ensuring that such units remain 8 affordable to persons at certain income levels. 9 In recent months, media reports have announced several 10 affordable housing projects that may be offered for sale, such 11 as the Kukui Gardens affordable rental housing project. Kukui 12 Gardens was built in part with federal funds and its 13 affordability restrictions will expire in five years. 14 The purpose of this Act is to preserve Kukui Gardens as an 15 affordable housing project. 16 SECTION 2. The Hawaii housing finance and development 17

- 1 Kukui Gardens Corp. to acquire the Kukui Gardens property, and
- 2 may partner with private developers for acquisition of the
- 3 property; provided that one hundred per cent of the housing
- 4 units on the property shall be retained in perpetuity as
- 5 affordable housing for households at or below one hundred twenty
- 6 per cent of the median family income as determined by the United
- 7 States Department of Housing and Urban Development.
- 8 The Hawaii housing finance and development administration
- 9 shall submit a report to the legislature no later than twenty
- 10 days prior to the convening of the regular session of 2007
- 11 regarding its efforts to acquire Kukui Gardens and its
- 12 recommendations for financing the purchase of the property.
- 13 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 15 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007 for land
- 16 acquisition of Kukui Gardens, tax map key 1-7-26:7, owned by
- 17 Kukui Gardens Corporation; provided that if an agreement to
- 18 acquire the property is not reached by June 30, 2007, the Hawaii
- 19 housing finance and development administration shall exercise
- 20 its power of eminent domain to acquire the property.

- 1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii
- 2 housing finance and development administration for the purposes
- 3 of this Act.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
