Act 178, part III, Session Laws of Hawaii 2005, 9 is amended by adding a new section to read as follows: 10 "SECTION 4.1. Provided that of the special fund appropriation for the tourism special fund in tourism (BED 113), 11 12 the sum of \$1,327,887 for fiscal year 2005-2006 and the sum of 13 \$1,327,887 for fiscal year 2006-2007 shall be transferred to economic planning and research (BED 130); provided further that 14 15 such transfer shall not be considered an expenditure from the 16 tourism special fund." 17 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006.
