1	SECT	ION 2. Chapter 346, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

4	" <u>§34</u>	6- Expenditure of temporary assistance for needy
5	families	funds. (a) Any funds received by the State under the
6	temporary	assistance for needy families program shall be subject
7	to approp	riation by the legislature and shall not be expended by
8	the department without a legislative appropriation.	
9	(b)	No later than thirty days before the convening of each
10	regular s	ession, the department shall:
11	(1)	Submit a plan to the legislature detailing how the
12		funds received under the temporary assistance for
13		needy families program will be expended and describing
14		the desired outcomes from the expenditure of the
15		funds; and
16	(2)	Report on the effectiveness and level of success in
17		reaching the desired outcomes under:
18		(A) The plan in paragraph (1); and

1	(B) Programs from the previous two fiscal years using		
2	temporary assistance for needy families funds.		
3	(e) In undertaking its responsibilities under this		
4	section, each house of the legislature shall refer all matters		
5	to all relevant standing committees."		
6	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that		
7	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were		
8	begun, before its effective date.		
9	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.		
10	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2099.
