A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PERMIT APPROVALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the automatic
2	approval of a permit by a state or county board or commission
3	may lead to unintended consequences. The county charters and
4	section 92-15, Hawaii Revised Statutes, generally require that a
5	majority of the full membership of a board or commission must
6	vote in favor of an action to make it valid. Sometimes, a board
7	or commission will take a vote that is neither an approval nor a
8	denial because of vacancies or absences or disqualified members
9	on the board or commission. It has been argued that this can
10	create an automatic approval, even when a majority of the
11	members of a board or commission present have voted against a
12	proposal. Where a vote has occurred and less than a majority of
13	the board or commission has approved a proposal, the matter
14	should be continued rather than approved.
15	SECTION 2. Section 91-13.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
16	amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
17	"(c) All [such] issuing agencies shall take action to
18	grant or deny any application for a business or development-

- 1 related permit, license, or approval within the established
- 2 maximum period of time, or the application shall be deemed
- 3 approved; provided that a delay in granting or denying an
- 4 application [caused by the lack of quorum] at a regular meeting
- 5 of the issuing agency shall not result in approval under this
- 6 subsection[; provided further that any subsequent lack of quorum
- 7 at a regular meeting of the issuing agency that delays the same
- 8 matter shall not give cause for further extension, unless an
- 9 extension is agreed to by all parties. if the delay was caused
- 10 by the lack of quorum, a tie vote, or a vote with less than a
- 11 majority of the full membership of the board or commission
- voting to approve the application."
- 13 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Provides that the automatic approval of applications for business- or development-related permits, licenses, or approvals will not occur when the board or commission making the review is delayed by a tie vote or a vote with less than a majority of the members of the commission or board present.
