A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Any agency of the State, including the Hawaii
2	community development authority, is prohibited from selling the
3	fee interest in any public lands in the Kakaako community
4	development district.
5	SECTION 2. Pursuant to part III, chapter 39, and part IV,
6	chapter 206E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the Hawaii community
7	development authority, with the approval of the governor, is
8	authorized to issue revenue bonds in a total amount not to
9	exceed \$ in one or more series, for the purpose of
10	implementing the approved plans for that portion of the Kakaako
11	community development district on the island of Oahu that is
12	makai of Ala Moana boulevard, between Kewalo basin and the
13	University of Hawaii, John A. Burns school of medicine; provided
14	that:
15	(1) The bonds shall be issued only if the income from the
16	project is insufficient to cover the project cost and
17	only to the extent of the shortfall; and

1	(2) No development funded by this Act shall include any
2	residential dwelling project on the Kakaako makai
3	property.
4	SECTION 3. The revenue bonds issued under this Act shall
5	be issued pursuant to part III, chapter 39, and part IV, chapter
6	206E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, relating to the power of the
7	Hawaii community development authority to issue revenue bonds to
8	develop public facility projects.
9	SECTION 4. The authorization to issue revenue bonds under
10	this Act shall lapse on June 30, 2011.
11	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;

provided that section 2 shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
