BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 46, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2	by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
3	read as follows:
4	"§46- Adult residential care homes; permitted use in
5	residential areas. (a) For the purposes of zoning, adult
6	residential care homes shall be considered a residential use of
7	property and shall be a permitted use in all residentially
8	designated zones, including but not limited to zones for single-
9	family dwellings. No conditional use permit, variance, or
10	special exception shall be required for residences used as adult
11	residential care homes.
12	(b) For the purposes of this section, "adult residential
13	care home" means any facility providing twenty-four-hour living
14	accommodations, for a fee, to adults unrelated to the family,
15	who require at least minimal assistance in the activities of
16	daily living, personal care services, protection, and health
17	care services, but who do not need the professional health

- 1 services provided in an intermediate, skilled nursing, or acute
- 2 care facility."

- 4 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
