## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	PART I		
2	SECTION 1. The purpose of this part is to:		
3	(1) Promote fiscal accountability with regard to		
4	agricultural land lease agreements between the State		
5	and lessees by authorizing the agribusiness		
6	development corporation to contract with financial		
7	institutions as lease income collection agents; and		
8	(2) Require agricultural leases of fifty-five years or		
9	greater for lands in the Waialua area on the island of		
10	Oahu acquired from the Galbraith Estate.		
11	SECTION 2. Section 163D-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
12	amended to read as follows:		
13	"[+]§163D-7[+] Agricultural projects; agricultural		
14	development plans. (a) The corporation may develop and		
15	implement agricultural projects where large tracts of		
16	agricultural land have been or will be taken out of productive		
17	agriculture or where, through detailed analysis, opportunities		

- 1 exist to exploit potential local, national, and international
- 2 markets.
- 3 (b) The corporation may initiate and coordinate the
- 4 preparation of business and agricultural development plans for
- 5 its projects. The plans shall include a proposal for the
- 6 organization of the enterprise, a marketing information and
- 7 strategy, the impact on existing agricultural operations
- 8 throughout the [State] state, and a recommendation for the
- 9 construction, reconstruction, rehabilitation, improvement,
- 10 alteration, or repair of any infrastructure or accessory
- 11 facilities in connection with any project.
- 12 (c) The corporation may enter into cooperative agreements
- 13 with coordinating entrepreneurs or public agencies when the
- 14 powers, services, and capabilities of the persons or agencies
- 15 are deemed necessary and appropriate for the development and
- 16 implementation of the business and agricultural development
- 17 plans.
- (d) Notwithstanding any provision of this chapter to the
- 19 contrary, when leasing corporation-controlled agricultural land,
- 20 the corporation may contract with a financial institution
- 21 chartered under chapter 412 or a federal financial institution,
- 22 as defined under section 412:1-109, that is transacting business

- 1 in this state to provide lease management services. For the
- purposes of this subsection, "lease management services"
- 3 includes the collection of lease rent and any other moneys owed
- 4 to the corporation related to the lease of agricultural land
- 5 under its control.
- 6 [\(\frac{(d)}{d}\)] (e) The agricultural planning activities of the
- 7 corporation shall be coordinated with the county planning
- 8 departments and the county land use plans, policies, and
- 9 ordinances.
- 10 [<del>(e)</del>] (f) The corporation may amend the business and
- 11 agricultural development plans as may be necessary.
- 12  $\left[\frac{f}{g}\right]$  (g) Any undertaking by the corporation pursuant to
- 13 this chapter shall be with the express written consent of the
- 14 landowner or landowners directly affected."
- 15 SECTION 3. Section 163D-15.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 "[+] §163D-15.6 Commitment and preservation of agricultural
- 18 leases.[+] (a) The [agribusiness development] corporation
- 19 shall work toward obtaining commitments from landowners in the
- 20 leeward and central districts of Oahu that their agricultural
- 21 leases shall be for a duration of twenty or more years, and
- 22 shall not be amended or revoked [in order] to allow for a

- 1 nonagricultural use of [such] that land[-]; provided that for
- 2 lands in the Waialua area on the island of Oahu acquired under
- 3 section 5 of this Act, the agricultural leases shall be for not
- 4 less than fifty-five years.
- 5 (b) To further ensure the preservation of agriculture in
- 6 the leeward and central districts of Oahu, the [agribusiness
- 7 development | corporation shall monitor the agricultural leases
- 8 of lands [utilizing] using the water from the Waiahole water
- 9 system. In the event of any proposed amendment or revocation of
- 10 any such lease, the corporation shall do all things within its
- 11 powers under [+] this chapter[+] to protect and defend the
- 12 interests of the agricultural leaseholders to ensure the
- 13 continuation of agricultural use for those lands."
- 14 PART II
- 15 SECTION 4. The purpose of this part is to comply with
- 16 article XI, sections 3 and 10 of the state constitution,
- 17 relating to the protection of agricultural lands and the
- 18 promotion of farm ownership and diversified agriculture, by
- 19 establishing a process to ensure that certain lands in the
- 20 Waialua area on the island of Oahu:
- 21 (1) Remain available for agricultural use;

1	(2)	Are properly managed to ensure their continued
2		economic viability while being used for agriculture;
3		and
4	(3)	Are managed in a manner that is sensitive to and
5		consistent with the needs of farmers in the Waialua
6		area.
7	The	legislature finds that this Act is in accordance with
8	article X	I, sections 3 and 10 of the state constitution, is in
9	the publi	c interest, and will preserve agricultural activities
10	in the ar	ea and a lifestyle that benefits the Waialua community
11	and the c	ommunity at large.
12	SECT	ION 5. (a) The agribusiness development corporation
13	shall acq	uire the agricultural lands located in the Waialua area
14	on the is	land of Oahu and owned by the Galbraith Estate.
15	(b)	The agribusiness development corporation shall submit
16	to the le	gislature a progress report on its actions to acquire
17	the Waial	ua agricultural lands no later than twenty days prior
18	to the co	nvening of the regular session of 2007.
19	SECT	ION 6. There is appropriated out of the general
20	revenues	of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much

thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2006-2007, to

- 1 acquire agricultural lands located in the Waialua area and owned
- 2 by the Galbraith Estate.
- 3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the agribusiness
- 4 development corporation for the purposes of this Act.
