- SECTION 1. Section 88-73, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1

- 3 "(d) Any [member of the legislature] elective officer who
- attains age sixty-five may retire and receive a service 4
- 5 retirement allowance although the [member] elective officer
- 6 continues to fill the elective position."
- SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 7
- and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 8
- SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2006. 9
