BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 76-22.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended to read as follows:
3	"§76-22.5 Recruitment. (a) The director shall adopt
4	rules in accordance with sections 76-1 and 78-1 to determine,
5	establish, and maintain the manner in which civil service
6	positions are to be filled. First consideration in filling
7	positions shall be given to regular employees already within the
8	public service. First consideration means that all regular
9	employees with satisfactory performance in the state service
10	shall be given first opportunity to be considered for vacancies.
11	(b) The director shall seek continuous improvements to
12	streamline the recruitment process so that positions are filled
13	in the most economic, efficient, and expeditious manner
14	possible. This includes maximizing use of new technologies and
15	developing more efficient alternatives to ensure the
16	availability of qualified applicant pools whether it involves a
17	change in the manner in which initial appointments are to be
